Pigs are warm, medium-sized animals.

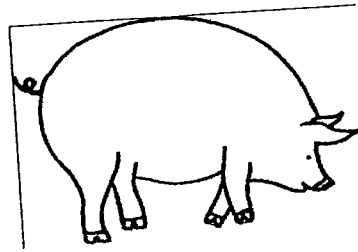
They make an oink sound. They have four legs and a little tail. Pigs have hooves on the end of their legs. Pigs also have a snout as their nose. This helps them to smell very well.
